



Dear Kindergarten Families,

Over the next two weeks students will create their Passion Project. During this time, students will use the attached packet as a guide to deeply study something they are interested in. During the two weeks, students are to work on their project at their own pace. See the table below and attached packet for the math activities to be completed during this time.

The live teaching sessions during these two weeks will revolve around the Passion Project. For example, the teacher will model how to do the Mind Map on page 3.

Completed projects are due on Friday, May 29 and can consist of one of the following to be submitted to your teacher through email or google classroom:

- A completed packet
- A video explaining what they have learned
- A multimedia presentation (lego structure, poster, diorama, collage, performance, etc)

Each day students are to continue to:

- Read at least 20-60 minutes
- Read, write, and spell sight words
- Practice counting to at least 100 by 1's, 5's, and 10's
- Practice addition and subtraction facts through 10
- Complete one page of the May Math Journal
- Practice reading "A Little Seed" Poem aloud during Week 1 and "Lucky Worm" aloud during Week 2
